EXPLANATORY NOTES ON REPORT ENTRY

Hypertensive disorders in pregnancy	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Chronic hypertension2. Gestational hypertension3. Pre-eclampsia/eclampsia4. Pre-eclampsia/eclampsia superimposed on chronic hypertension
Cardiac disease	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Rheumatic valvular disease2. Congenital heart disease3. Mitral valve prolapse4. Arrhythmia requiring treatment or regular cardiac treatment5. Others
Diabetes mellitus	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pre-existing DM – known DM before the indexed pregnancy disregarding treatment was instituted or not (including impaired glucose tolerance/impaired fasting glucose or glycaemia)2. DM in pregnancy3. Gestational DM
Renal disease	- Disease of the urinary tract during pregnancy either <ol style="list-style-type: none">a. with symptoms orb. with impaired renal function orc. requiring treatment Asymptomatic bacteriuria is EXCLUDED
Liver disease	- Liver diseases during pregnancy with impaired liver function
Respiratory disease	- Only those requiring treatment during pregnancy or with impaired respiratory function Upper respiratory tract infection is EXCLUDED
Psychiatric disease	- Include only those requiring hospitalization and treatment Only those requiring treatment during pregnancy
Immunological disease	- Include only those requiring hospitalization and treatment Only those requiring treatment during pregnancy
Thyroid disease	- Include only those requiring hospitalization and treatment Only those requiring treatment during pregnancy
Surgical disease	- Major surgical conditions / laparotomy or major operations that require general anaesthesia during pregnancy or puerperium (except PPS)
Hysterectomy	- Include those performed up to 6 weeks postpartum
Birth trauma	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Cephalohaematoma2. Soft tissue trauma e.g. laceration3. Subaponeurotic haemorrhage4. Intracranial haemorrhage5. Fractures6. Nerve injuries7. Visceral injuries
